A motion was made by Michelle Martin amend rule that a coach must be next to the R1 when their team is officiating to insure proper calls and conduct. If that does not occur, that team will receive a 5 point penalty during their next game. It was seconded by Kari Cellan.

Kari Cellan made a motion that if a team leaves the facility without performing their officiating duties, that team will be penalized at the next tourney with a 0-25 score during their first game (game will still be played). The tourney director must verify that this did indeed occur. Wade Wells seconded the motion.

Craig Allred made a motion that Chris Woegens be the rules coordinator. Wade Wells seconded the motion.

Craig Allred mentioned that the will be set times to update the site so that is is cost effective.
